President

- Lead and represent the Association

Vice President

- Assume responsibilities of the President in his/her absence
- Chair the Bylaws Committee
- Perform other duties as assigned

Secretary

- Record and keep the minutes of Board and Membership Meetings
- Ensure city, board and membership receive minutes per the bylaws (E-mail OK)
- E-mail/mail notices to members

Treasurer

- Receive and disburse Association funds as directed by the board
- Track and monitor monthly expenses
- Report on the status of the funds

Land Use Chair

- Consult with the President or Board to coordinate Early Neighborhood Notification as required by City of Gresham code
- Make Association public comment on land use applications or code changes
