Below is the City of Gresham Budget Development Process Calendar.

City of Gresham Budget Development Process Calendar:

July-November

Process Design and Financial Forecasting. Finance Department forecasts how much funds city will have for the next fiscal year. Fiscal year is July 1 – June 30.

(This is a good time period for public comments at the beginning of council work plan development meetings. Write letters to council and city manager. See City of Gresham Council members: [www.greshamoregon.gov](http://www.greshamoregon.gov) . There is a list of email addresses.)

November-January

Develop Budget Proposals and Capital Improvement Plan. Various departments create their proposed want list budgets.

February-March

Balance forecasted funds with departments' proposed budgets.

April-May

Budget Committee Deliberations – Budget Committee consists of Finance Committee members and City Council members. The balanced proposed budget is presented to the Budget Committee. Time is given for public comment. (Note: It is very difficult to influence the Budget Committee and to make changes at this point.)

June

Council Adopts Budget and Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). The CIP is a five year plan of large capital construction projects such as for streets and water. Public Comment.

July 1

Budget is Implemented
