

**Northwest Neighborhood Association Board meeting**  
**Monday, June 17, 2019**

We were awarded \$2,195 from the city's matching grant program.

We have been asked to host a free workshop through the East Multnomah Soil & Water Conservation District in the fall. There are many possible workshop topics, including native plants, beneficial insects, attracting pollinators, urban weeds, etc. Barb said she is willing to host the event.

We will have a picnic planning meeting Monday, July 15, at 7:30 p.m. Kat will let Naomi and Elizabeth know.

Barb will go to the Gresham Art Walk to buy some raffle prizes on Saturday, July 20. She also suggested buying tubs of ice cream and cones instead of the ice cream bars this year. Kat suggested a variety of ice cream flavors, including a dairy free option.

Kat said she will be in charge of the children's games again. Barb will buy four I-Candy gift cards.

The May minutes were approved.
