

# Gresham Redevelopment Commission Meetings

## Speaking Guidelines

The Gresham Redevelopment Commission encourages citizens to talk about issues that are important to them. If you would like to address the Commission, here is how to do so properly:

### **IF YOU WISH TO SPEAK**

Come forward to the speaker table and **STATE YOUR NAME ONLY** for the record.

### **LENGTH OF COMMENTS**

Please observe the time limit of **THREE MINUTES**. You will address the Commission from the speaker table microphone. The light on the podium will turn green when your 3 minutes begin, turn yellow when you have 30 seconds to wrap up, and then will turn red and beep when your 3 minutes is over.

### **CITIZEN COMMENTS FOR AGENDA ITEMS** – Blue Sign-up Sheet

You must address the Commission on any Commission-related agenda item (with the exception of Public Hearings) at the place on the agenda for “Citizen Comments.”

**Print** your name on the **BLUE** Citizen & Community Group Participation Sign-Up sheet located on the table with other documents for the meeting and give to the Recording Secretary.

### **WRITTEN COMMENTS**

If you would prefer to make written comments on any agenda item, you may do so. Please furnish the Recording Secretary at least one copy of your written documentation to be included in the City’s official records.
