 - c. We may be getting grant money to be used for the East Gresham Park, maybe to buy native plants or to get a plan drawn up for planting. Britt Mccon is the contact for that grant.
4. Land Use Update:
 - a. 28th of April received a notice and lost it in email so didn't get a chance to act on that.
 - b. Dogtown preapp was received for a new DogTown facility near their current building. Not in our NA.
 - c. Received some information on a street plan at the end of SE 2nd. Still in pre-app stage. No ENN required yet.
5. Graffiti Concerns:
 - a. Powell and onto SE 1st tagging mailboxes and other public property
 - b. Hasn't reported it on MyGresham because there are so many of them. Stella will

help Janet to report the tagging in hopes that the city still has volunteers to remove it.

6. Build a Parks and Rec Program information request (received by Stella via PRCAG committee):
 - a. Looked at the information form that Stella has been asked to complete
 - b. Suggested that she consider responses that emphasize spending at small, local parks over big central projects.
 - c. Desire expressed for better coordination of resources between private and public (pools, golf courses, pickleball courts, etc.)

7. Attracting New Board Members:
 - a. Might chat with people at the neighborhood garage
