Welcome and introductions around the table.

In attendance: 4 people

The group received a request from Grow Together Gresham to support behind a minimum wage increase to around \$13.25. There was mixed support behind encouraging a living wage, but also the impact it would have on small businesses. The association will not publically back this initiative as a group without full support of those in attendance. Individuals are welcome to contact the group with their own personal support if desired.

Group Christmas Donation: Due to the small size of our group, we feel it would be best to go with more inexpensive items to make a larger impact on what we can provide. No decision has been made on who we will be making the donation to.

Rosalyn Hamilton's Announcements:

Cell phone tower by Reynolds School at 202nd and holiday: Concerns were presented about the health impact of cell phone towers. There is an online website called AntennaSearch to look up all the cell towers.

Backyard Bird Habitat Certification: Costs \$35 to join, there is a certification criteria to meet. You will receive coupons and info.

Code Compliance Program: Concern about regulation regarding public requests for information. Unhappy about photos of front and rear of home being available to people who are not necessarily entitled to that information. The process behind code violation reports, being able to look up the information at the City and go through the process to have the inspection done felt very demeaning in her experience.

Land Use:

There was the pre-application meeting about the homes being built off Cleveland. No one from the association was in attendance, however, meeting minutes indicate the neighbors were not in support.
