Explanation of Charges

Utility bill charges are based on rates set by City Council. These charges support work to:

- Plan, design, operate and maintain utility infrastructure. This includes wastewater (sewer), stormwater and drinking water services.
- Protect public health and the environment.
- Comply with state and federal regulations.

Police, Fire and Parks (PFP) Fee

The PFP Fee provides critical funding to support police, fire and parks services.

Water

- The base charge is determined by the water meter size.
- The usage charge is based on the amount of water used in the billing period. One unit of water equals 100 cubic feet or 748 gallons.

Wastewater (Sewer)

- The base charge is determined by customer classification (such as residential or commercial).
- The Winter Water Average units are based on water use during the preceding October – April. Where no account average is available, the City will apply a default amount.

Stormwater

• The charge is based on the impervious area of each property.
