





#### Parking: What is Working Well?

- Things that make parking easy (signage, striping, areas of surplus, cost)
- What "benefits" customers?
- Other?






#### Parking: What is NOT Working Well?

- Specific areas where problems are more common?
- Times of day, days of week, seasons?
- Specific programs (e.g., signage, time stays, etc.)
- Inadequate facilities (e.g., sidewalk gaps, missing bike lanes, poor lighting)
- Discomfort (e.g., narrow sidewalks, high vehicle speeds, blind corners)



#### **Establishing Priorities**

- Should employees be allowed to park <u>on-street</u> in the commercial downtown?
- Should business/property owners be allowed to park on-street in the commercial downtown?
- Should downtown residents be allowed to park onstreet in the commercial downtown?
- Should employees be allowed to park <u>on-street</u> in residential neighborhoods?
- Should downtown customers be allowed to park <u>on-street</u> in residential neighborhoods?









#### **Establishing Priorities**

- Who should be the priority user of the on-street system in downtown?
- Who should be the priority user of the off-street system in the downtown?
- Who should be the priority user of the on-street system in the neighborhoods around downtown?
